

Instructor Job Description

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides course instruction for the Joint Construction Management System (JCMS), including proofing of material. As required, helps develop training programs of instruction, practices and procedures for training personnel on JCMS courses. Responsible to assist Senior Instructors in the development, testing, and maintenance of training curriculum. With supervision, helps in development and presentation of educational technology such as Computer Base Training (CBT) or Web Base Training (WBT). Keeps abreast of training and development research: learning theory, motivation theory, and new materials, methods, and techniques.

QUALIFICATIONS

REQUIRED EDUCATION/SKILLS: Bachelor's Degree in training, construction or related field; an Associate degree may be substituted with at least two years professional experience in DoD style instruction. Construction trades experience of at least two years preferably with the Theater Construction Management System (TCMS). Experience with military contingency engineering/construction; Army Facilities Components System (AFCS) experience is preferred.

DESIRED SKILLS: Experience with the AFCS and TCMS
