

ENGINEER TRAINING INSTRUCTOR POSITION JOB DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Innovative instructor to provide Engineer Field Force Engineering team training support to improve the teams' capabilities in meeting current and emerging contingency requirements. Instructor must be experienced in preparing and executing instruction for technical military engineer training. Instruction is primarily focused on Forward Engineer Support Team members for the Base Camp Development Program Course (BCDP) (the basic course for FEST A and M teams) and instruction on the Theater Construction Management System (TCMS). The instructor must also be knowledgeable of the Army's Field Manual 7-0, Training Units and Developing Leaders for Full Spectrum Operations; Mission Essential Task List (METL) development; and the Army Force Generation (ARFORGEN) model. Instructor must be experienced in development and modification of military Programs of Instruction.
